The Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship is a full tuition and housing college scholarship for golf caddies. Since 1930, more than 9,400 men and women have graduated as Evans Scholars, with most recipients attending one of the 14 universities across the nation where the Evans Scholars Foundation owns and operates a Scholarship House.

The Program, sponsored by the Western Golf Association in Golf, Illinois, was started by Chicago golf amateur Charles "Chick" Evans, Jr. Today, 100,000 golfers nationwide support Evans Scholars, making it one of the country's largest privately funded scholarship programs.
