Full tuition and housing college scholarships available for caddies



More than 830 deserving caddies across the country attend college on a full tuition and housing scholarship each year from the Evans Scholars Foundation.

Evans Scholars live together in a Scholarship House, electing officers and running social and service events.

Over 8,600 men and women have graduated from college as Evans Scholars. The program is sponsored by the Western Golf Association in Golf, Illinois.

Evans Scholarship Requirements

- **Strong caddie record:** Students must have caddied regularly for at least two years.
- **Excellent grades:** They must complete their junior year with above a "B" average in college prep classes and take the ACT.
- **Demonstrated financial need:** They must show a need for financial help.
- **Outstanding character:** They must show outstanding character, integrity and leadership.
