2014 Program Overview

The Evans Scholars Foundation, sponsored by the Western Golf Association, is the nation's largest scholarship program for golf caddies, providing full tuition and housing at leading universities across the country.



The Evans Scholars Foundation was founded in 1930 by the Western Golf Association and Charles "Chick" Evans Jr., one of the most celebrated amateur golfers of all time. Since then, more than 9,800 men and women have graduated as Evans Scholars. Currently, 840 students are enrolled at 19 universities across the nation, including 14 where the Evans Scholars Foundation owns and operates Scholarship Houses.

The need for the Evans Scholarship continues to grow. College tuitions are on the rise, and the Foundation is receiving record numbers of Scholarship applications. To meet these challenges, plans are in place to grow the number of Scholars in school while expanding the organization's geographic footprint from coast to coast. Today, more than 26,000 Par Club donors nationwide support the Evans Scholars Foundation. The Foundation also is the sole beneficiary of the BMW Championship, a PGA TOUR Playoff event conducted annually by the Western Golf Association. To learn more, please visit www.wgaesf.org.
